

Can demographic and health surveys help to understand the determinants? The quality and usefulness of existing survey data is considered, including issues related to the use of the Mosley-Chen framework in studying child survival. It is proposed that limiting the health section of large scale sample surveys to a few indicators, and carrying out in-depth studies of smaller samples on specific topics, could be more fruitful. Integrated in-depth studies could also allow for more developing country involvement, and help to strengthen local institutions.
