The Standard Dictionary defines a steward as, 1. A person entrusted with the management of estates or affairs not his own; one who manages or disburses for another. 2. An agent appointed by a Lord of the manor to lease lands, collect rents, etc.; sometime having also summary magisterial powers. The term trustee has somewhat the same meaning in legal circles, but it is too contracted and limited in its meaning really to cover the Biblical term steward.
